Master's Students: Up to 9 of the 30 minimum credit hours, or up to 30% of the total credit hours required for programs with more than 30-hour requirements, may be transferred from accredited institutions or from other graduate programs within this institution. Grades earned on transferred work must be equivalent to B or better. Transferred credit will not be included in the program residence credit calculation.

Doctoral Students: There is no limit to the number of hours that can be transferred into a doctoral program to meet course requirements—with the academic program's approval. Graduate coursework must be from accredited institutions or from other graduate programs within this institution. Grades earned on transferred work must be equivalent to B or better. Transferred credit will not be included in the program residence credit calculation.
